- Assist with the evaluation of the performance of the Executive Director.
- Help the organization strive for inclusivity and diversity.

The Treasurer also shall:

- Review and approve monthly expenses.
- Work with the Executive Director to prepare annual budgets and mid-year reviews.
- Report on the financial status of the organization at each board meeting (every other month).
- Ensure that taxes are completed each year.
